

Levels

This admin page controls geographic navigation levels.

Region Type Information

- **Country**
 - Level must be **above** the *State or Province* if used, and **above** the *City* if used.
 - Only one level marked as Country.
 - Used to display the country or select the country in various places in the software.
 - Used by some **payment gateways**, so make sure that the Country Abbreviation is set to the official country code for regions in this level. If the abbreviation is not correct, payment gateways that use this information may fail to process any transactions.
 - Used to **map** the location of listings or storefronts if you have mapping enabled and the poster selects to show the map.
- **State or Province**
 - Level must be **below** the *Country* if used, and **above** the *City* if used.
 - Only one level marked as State or Province.
 - Used to display the state/province or select the state/province in various places within the software.
 - Used by some **payment gateways**, so make sure that the State or Province Abbreviation is set to the official state/province code for regions in this level. If the abbreviation is not correct or not set, payment gateways that use this information may fail to process any transactions.
 - Used to **map** the location of listings or storefronts if you have mapping enabled and the poster selects to show the map.
- **City**
 - Level must be **below** the *Country* if used, and **below** the *State or Province* if used.
 - Only one level marked as City.
 - Used to display the city or select the city in various places within the software.
 - Used to **map** the location of listings or storefronts if you have mapping enabled and the poster selects to show the map.
- **Other**
 - Can be above or below any other region type, even between two other types such as between Country and State or Province.
 - No limit to how many levels can be of type "other".
 - Region collected and saved for users and listings.
 - Used to display the full location breadcrumb of a listing.
 - If the level is "labelled", regions in this level can be displayed when browsing the site, depending on fields to use settings.
